



The resource person for the session was *Mr. Neeraj Tiwari*, Associate Director of Academia India.


About the Session:

The modules covered included Statistics and Reports, Market Insights, Consumer Insights, Company Insights, and E-commerce. Mr. Tiwari conducted a hands-on demonstration, illustrating how to access information within Statista and guiding participants on downloading data in various formats, including PDFs, PPTs, Excels, and more.

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Features of Arrupe Central Library

Arrupe Central Library, St. Xavier's College Jaipur is the first state-of-art library in Rajasthan. It has many features which are enabled with ICT. Look at a glance of special features of our library:

Digital Initiatives:

- Self-Circulation Kiosk Facility: Arrupe Central Library Implement Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) enable KIOSK, this latest technology used to automate bookhandling process including checkout, checkin, inventory maintenance. The technology would allow the readers to utilize the service of self 'issue', 'reissue' and 'return' books without standing in a queue.
- Anti-theft Security Gate: RFID technology helps to alert the library security staff in case unintentionally/intentionally proper procedure of book issue/return is not followed.
- Computerised Entry System: Computerised IN-OUT system at the library entrance not only by biometric but also by ID Card, enables to record attendance efficiently.
- Library Webpage Facility: Separate library webpage is available at the college website (www.sxcjpr.edu.in). Users can know about the library through this page.
- Library Web-OPAC Facility: Library operations are fully automated using open-source software KOHA(Version 23.11.03) and online catalogue for books is accessible through link Koha online catalog (librarywebopac. sxcjpr.edu.in)
- E-Mail /SMS Notification Service: An email/SMS is received by users for any transaction(issue/return/renewal) in the library.

E-resources:

- Institutional Repository Facility: Inhouse publications, previous year question papers, question bank, E-books etc. can be accessed through DSPACE link. DSpace at St. Xavier's College: Home (sxcjpr.edu.in)
- **Library Access through QR Codes:** QR codes are available on every floor of campus to access library resources.
- Plagiarism Check Facility: As a research facility, Turitin anti-plagiarism software is available in the library to check on plagiarism.
- Consortium e-Resources Access and Research Tools
 Access Facility: Online Research tools and consortiums like
 N-LIST and DELNET are accessible in the library. There are
 many computers with internet connection for accessing E Resource. Available E-Resources are E-Journals through N LIST, JSTOR, DELNET, NDL, E-Magazines Harvard
 Business Review, Down to Earth, E-papers/The Hindu,
 Business Line, Statista platform for statistics requirements
 and many more open access e- resources.

Other Initiatives:

- Divyangjan Facilities: Kibo XS Device (for the visually impaired) is available in the library, which has following the features: -
- Text-to-speech technology, Optical Character Recognition (OCR), Tactile Controls and Integrated audio controls. It is lightweight and portable.
- Ramp and sensor gate make the library easily accessible.

Services and Facilities:

- **Uniform Rack System:** There are similar racks in the library which create uniformity in the library.
- **Reprography:** One photocopy machine is available in the library for reprography and printing facilities.
- Previous years question papers and Question Bank:
 Previous years question papers can be accessed through
 DSPACE. Hard copies of some question papers are also available.
- **Reference Service Facility:** There is a separate section for reference books in the library.
- **New Arrivals Display Facility:** Newly arrived books are displayed in the New Arrivals section.
- In-House Publications Display Facilities: In-House publications and books of in-house authors are displayed in this section
- Career Guidance: Books related to UGC NET and other competitive examinations are available in the library.
- **Newspaper Section:** There are many English and Hindi newspapers available in the library. E-papers can also be accessed in the library.
- Periodical Section: There is a separate section for print journals and magazines in the library. E-Journals and E-Magazines can be accessed through the library e resource section.

- **Personal Belongings Racks:** Racks are available outside the library for keeping personal belongings.
- CDs Section: CDs are also available in the library.
- Rare Books, Holy Books Access Facility: Some old and rare books are available in the library. A separate section for holy books is also maintained.
- **Reading Room:** There is a ventilated reading room with comfortable tables and chairs in the library. There is a spacious reading area in the library.
- **Lending Counter:** Two counters are available in the library for book issue / return process by staff station device.
- E-library: Computer facility for online content and resources.
